

# D&T in Our Local Context



D&T is taught in 6-lesson units, once a term (D&T alternates with Art).

The United Curriculum is sequenced so that meaningful links are made between subjects, and the order of units allows these connections to be made.

The United Curriculum for Design & Technology has been adapted for The Galfrid School by considering the context of our pupils and the community.

For example:

- Our allotment will grow food for a pupils to use during cooking units.
- Home grow scheme with the local council to get pupils to understand how food grows.
- Parents chefs to demonstrate how to cook meals.
- Stem Scientist projects to teach Year 5/6 MicroBits.
